

Hunter/Equitation Prize List

Subject to any specific cross entering rules of a given class – Same Horse/Rider combination is limited to entering a maximum of two divisions per day in any Hunter Arena. A horse or pony may only enter a maximum of 3 o/f divisions per day.

Bainbridge Farms Lead Line Equitation: For junior riders 8 y/o and under who have not competed in any other classes at any horse show. Riders are ineligible for any other class at this show. “Trot” class: At judge’s discretion, one at a time, rider w/handler to trot a few steps demonstrating posting (**no diagonals**). Exhibitors’ option to not trot is not to be cause for elimination. To be judged on the fundamentals of horsemanship and suitability of mount to child. Protective headgear and correct shoes or boots with heels are required. Handlers will be permitted in the Walk off the lead class, riders to walk in both directions.

Platinum Sponsors Walk-Trot Hunter: Riders in this class must not have reached their 13th birthday and are not eligible for any other classes on same show day except Hunter Pleasure. To jump one cross-rail in one class. To be judged on manners, suitability and way of going.

Platinum Sponsors Walk Trot Equitation: Same specifications as Walk Trot Hunter with additional emphasis on rider’s equitation.

Junior/Adult Walk-Trot Hunter: For riders 13 years of age and older. Rider is not eligible for any other classes on same show day except Hunter Pleasure. To jump one cross rail in one class. To be judged on manners, suitability and way of going.

Junior/Adult Walk Trot Equitation: Same specifications as Junior/Adult Walk Trot Hunter with additional emphasis on rider’s equitation.

Camp Canyon Cross Rails Hunter 17 and Under: Open to riders 17 years of age and under. To jump a simple course of 8 cross rails. Rider **MUST** trot into each line, but may canter down the line to the second jump. If rider trots down the line, diagonals are not be penalized. U/S to be judged at the walk and trot only. To be judged on manner, suitability and way of going with additional emphasis on rider’s equitation in equitation classes. **Rider is NOT eligible to enter ANY other classes on same show day except Hunter Pleasure.**

Cross Rails Hunter 18 and Over: Open to riders 18 years of age and older. To jump a simple course of 8 cross rails. Rider **MUST** trot into each line, but may canter down the line to the second jump. If rider trots down the line, diagonals are not to be penalized. U/S to be judged at the walk and trot only. To be judged on manner, suitability, and way of going with additional emphasis on rider’s equitation in equitation classes. **Rider is NOT eligible to enter ANY other classes on same show day except Hunter Pleasure.**

Camp Canyon Cross Rails Equitation 17 and Under: Same specifications as Camp Canyon Cross Rails Hunter 17 and under with additional emphasis on rider's equitation.

Cross Rails Equitation 18 and Over: Same specifications as Cross Rails Hunter 18 and over with additional emphasis on rider's equitation.

Wellington Show Stables Short Stirrup Hunter: Riders in this class must not have reached their 13th birthday, must be in their first or second year of showing, and are not eligible for any other O/F class on same show day, except the Lyn Walton Medal class, and the 2' Hunter Hack. To jump a simple course of 18". To be judged on manners, suitability and way of going. Simple lead changes or trot steps are not to be penalized..

Wellington Show Stables Short Stirrup Equitation: Same specifications as Short Stirrup Hunter except rider's equitation to be emphasized.

Lyn Walton Memorial Medal: Same specifications as Short Stirrups Equitation. Top 4 riders to test at judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-9 only).

Carriage Hill Long Stirrup Hunter: Open to rider's aged 13 and older. To jump a simple course of 18" or 2' (rider's choice). Manners and suitability to be emphasized. Simple lead changes or trot steps are not to be penalized. No professionals. Rider is not eligible to enter any other o/f classes on same show day except 2' Hunter Hack.

Carriage Hill Long Stirrup Equitation: Same specifications as Long Stirrup Hunter with additional emphasis on rider's equitation.

Hunter Hack 2': Open to all horses and ponies. To be judged at the walk, trot and canter, both ways of the ring. To jump two 2' fences. Open to any horse/pony jumping any height in the Novice Arena Except CrossRails; any horse/pony not showing o/f in the Advance Arena; and any horse/pony in the Intermediate Arena.

Equus Equestrian Center Equitation 13 and Under: Open to riders who have not reached their 14th birthday. To jump a simple course of 2'3". Same horse/rider combination may not x-enter to o/f classes exceeding 2'3" on same show day.

Platinum Sponsors Children's Horse or Pony Hunter: Open to riders who have not reached their 14th birthday. To jump a course of 2'3". Manners and suitability to be emphasized. Same horse/rider combination may not cross enter to o/f classes exceeding 2'3" on same show day.

Platinum Sponsors Children's Horse or Pony Equitation: Same specifications as Children's Horse or Pony Hunter except rider's equitation to be emphasized.

Bainbridge Farms Sm/Med Pony Hunter: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Manners and suitability to be emphasized. To jump 2". Same horse/rider combination may not cross enter to o/f exceeding 2'3" on same show day.

Charles Moorcroft Inc. Pony Medal: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. To jump a course of 2'. Top 4 riders may be tested. Same horse/rider combination is not eligible to enter the Carriage Hill 2'3" medal. Same horse/rider combination may enter any other division not exceeding 2'3" in the Intermediate Arena.

Carriage Hill Medal: Open to junior riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. To jump an equitation course of 2'3". Top 4 riders may be tested. Same horse/rider combination may not cross enter to an O/F exceeding 2'3" on the same show day.

Platinum Sponsors Low Schooling Hunter 2'3": To jump a simple course of 2'3". Same horse /rider combination not eligible for any other O/F classes exceeding 2'3" on same show day except 2'6" Hunter Hack. Open to professionals and non-professionals.

Pinehurst Stables Low Jr/Adult Amateur Hunter 2'3": Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders only. Same horse/rider combination may not cross enter to O/F classes exceeding 2'3" on same show day except 2'6" Hunter Hack. Manners and suitability to be emphasized.

Pinehurst Stables Low Jr. /Adult Amateur Equitation 2'3": Same specifications as Low Jr. /Adult Amateur Hunter with additional emphasis on rider's equitation.

Hunter Pleasure: Open to horses and ponies. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance, soundness, and the ability to give a pleasurable ride. Emphasis on suitability to rider and purpose. No martingales.

Hunter Hack 2'6": Open to horses and ponies. Horses to walk, trot, canter both directions. To jump two 2'6" fences. Any horse/pony jumping any height in the Advance Arena is eligible.

Fox Stone Farm Low Hunter 2'6": To jump a course of 2'6". Open to professionals and non-professionals. Same horse/rider combination may not cross enter to o/f classes exceeding 2'6" on same show day. To be judged on manners and suitability.

Capella Farms Adult Amateur Hunter 2'6": Open to adult amateur riders 18 years and older only. To jump a course of 2'6". Manners and suitability to be emphasized. Same horse/rider combination may not cross enter to o/f classes exceeding 2'6" on same show day.

Capella Farms Adult Equitation 2'6": To jump a course of 2'6". Same specifications as Ad/Am Hunter.

Hunter's View Adult Medal: Open to rider 18 years and older. To jump a course of not less than eight obstacles. Top 4 riders to test, USEF tests 1-19. Same horse/rider combination not eligible to cross enter to any O/F exceeding 2'6" on same show day.

Margaux Grossman Memorial Children's Hunter: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. To jump a course of 2'6". Same horse/rider combination may not cross enter where fences exceed 2'6" on same show day. Manners and suitability to be emphasized. Special Perpetual Trophy awarded.

Equus Equestrian Center 17 & Under Equitation: Same specifications as Children's Hunter w/additional emphasis on rider's equitation.

Dee Parker Memorial Medal: Open to junior riders under 18 years of age. To jump a course of not less than eight obstacles at 2'6". Top four required to test, USEF Tests 1-19. Same horse/rider combination may not cross enter to O/F exceeding 2'6" on same show day.

Boynton Dental Large Pony Hunter: Open to large ponies and junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Manners and suitability to be emphasized. To jump 2'6". Same horse/rider combination may cross enter only to 2'6" classes in the Advanced Arena.

Geoff Teall Montoga Inc. Modified Hunter 2'9": Open to both professional and non-professional riders. To jump a course of 2'9". Manners and suitability to be emphasized. Same horse/rider combination not eligible to cross enter any O/F exceeding 2'9" same show day.

Zimmerman Advertising Jr./Adult Hunter 2'9": Open to Junior and Adult amateur riders. To jump a course of 2'9". Same horse/rider combination not eligible to cross enter any O/F exceeding 2'9" same show day.

Zimmerman Advertising Jr./Adult Equitation 2'9": Open to Junior and Adult amateur riders. To jump a course of 2'9" with emphasis on rider's equitation. Same horse/rider combination not eligible to cross enter any O/F exceeding 2'9" same show day.

Black Swan Stables Junior/Adult Amateur Hunter 3': Open to junior and adult amateur riders. Manners and suitability to be emphasized.

Black Swan Stables Junior/Adult Equitation 3': To jump a course of 3'. Same specifications as Jr/Adult Amateur Hunter.

Tulocay Farm Medal: Open to junior and adult amateur riders. To jump at least 8 obstacles at 3'. Top four required to test, USEF Tests 1-19).

Charles Moorcroft Inc. Working Hunter 3': Open to professionals and non-professionals. To jump 3'. Manners and suitability to be emphasized.
