NOVICE RING

Lead Line Equitation: Open to riders 6 years and under as of December 1st. To be shown at the walk. Schooling and office fees are waived for this class only. Membership is required. Stall and/or grounds fees are not waived. Not eligible for any other class except 251.

Class 201

Lead Line Equitation/Walk 2 Rails – 6 & under: Open to riders 6 years and under as of December 1st. To be shown at a walk and demonstrate two point over two ground rails with handler.

Schooling and office fees are waived for this class only. Membership is required. Stall and/or grounds fees are not waived. Not eligible for any other class except Class 201.

Class 251

Walk Equitation - 8 & Under: Open to riders 8 and under as of December 1st. To be shown at the walk. Handlers will NOT be allowed in this class. Not eligible for any other class except Class 252.

Class 202

Walk Equitation/Walk 2 Rails - 8 & Under: Open to riders 8 and under as of December 1st. To be shown at the walk and demonstrate two point over two ground rails. Handlers will NOT be allowed in this class. Not eligible for any other class except 202.

Class 252

Walk Trot Hunter - 12 & Under: Open to riders 12 and under as of December 1st. To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. To be judged on suitability and way of going. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter into any other classes on same show day.

Class 101, 102

Walk Trot Hunter Jump an X - 12 & Under: Open to riders 12 and under as of December 1st. To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring and jump one 12" X. To be judged on manner and suitability. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other classes on same show day.

Class 103

Walk Trot Equitation – 12 & Under: Open to riders 12 and under as of December 1st. To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other equitation classes on same show day except Class 205. Judging emphasis is on rider's equitation.

Class 203, 204

Walk Trot Equitation Jump an X – 12 & Under: Open to riders 12 and under as of December 1st. To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring and jump one 12" X. To be judged on manner, suitability, and way of going with additional emphasis on rider's equitation. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other equitation classes on same show day except 203, 204.

Class 205

Cross Rails Warm-Up (Open Card): No year-end awards. No points or ribbons to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height until next height change. May cross enter to ANY warmup class in Novice or Advanced rings.

Class 401, 409

Cross Rails Hunter Trot: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. To jump a simple course of 8 cross rails. Rider MUST trot to first jump of each line but may trot or canter out. To be judged on manner, suitability, and way of going. Same horse/rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other classes on the same show day. U/S class will be walk-trot only.

Class 104, 105, 106

Cross Rails Equitation Trot: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. To jump a simple course of 8 cross rails. Rider MUST trot to first jump of each line but may trot or canter out. To be judged on manner, suitability, and way of going with additional emphasis on rider's equitation. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other equitation classes on the same show day. Flat class will be walk-trot only.

Class 206, 207, 208

Cross Rails Hunter Canter: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. To jump a simple course of 8 cross rails. To be judged on manner, suitability, and way of going. Simple lead changes not penalized at judge's discretion. Same horse/rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other classes on the same show day. U/S class will be walk-trot-canter.

Class 107, 108, 109

Cross Rails Equitation Canter: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. To jump a simple course of 8 cross rails. To be judged on manner, suitability, and way of going with additional emphasis on rider's equitation. Simple lead changes not penalized at judge's discretion. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other equitation classes on the same show day. Flat class will be walk-trot-canter.

Class 209, 210, 211

Cross Rails Adult Hunter: Open to riders 18 and over. To jump a simple course of 8 cross rails. To be judged on manner, suitability, and way of going. Simple lead changes not penalized at judge's discretion. Same horse/rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other classes on the same show day. U/S class will be walk-trot only. Open to amateurs only.

Class 110, 111, 112

Cross Rails Adult Equitation: Open to riders 18 and over. To jump a simple course of 8 cross rails. To be judged on manner, suitability, and way of going with additional emphasis on rider's equitation. Simple lead changes not penalized at judge's discretion. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other equitation classes on the same show day. Flat class will be walk-trot only. Open to amateurs only.

Class 212, 213, 214

Cross Rails Medal: Same specifications as Cross Rails Equitation and Adult Cross Rails Equitation. Medal open to both cross rail canter and cross rail adult divisions. Rider must canter the course. Top 4 riders may test at judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-9 only)

Class 309

Revised 10/20/2025

Warmup 18" (Open Card): No year-end awards. No points or ribbons to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height until next height change. May cross enter to ANY warmup class in Novice or Advanced rings.

Class 402, 410

Short Stirrup Hunter 14 & Under: Riders in this class may not have reached their 14th birthday as of December 1st. To jump a simple course at 18". To be judged on manners, suitability, and way of going. Simple lead changes not penalized at judge's discretion. Same horse/rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other O/F on same show day.

Class 113, 114, 115

Short Stirrup Equitation 14 & Under: Same specifications as Short Stirrup Hunter except rider's equitation to be emphasized. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other equitation O/F on same show day, except the Lyn Walton Medal.

Class 215, 216, 217

Rusty Stirrup Hunter 15 & Over: Riders in this class must have reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st. To jump a simple course of 18". To be judged on manners, suitability, and way of going. Simple lead changes not penalized at judge's discretion. Same horse/rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other O/F on same show day except the Lyn Walton Memorial. Open to amateurs only.

Classes 116, 117, 118

Rusty Stirrup Equitation 15 & Over: Same specifications as Rusty Stirrup Hunter except rider's equitation to be emphasized. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other equitation O/F on same show day except the Lyn Walton Medal. Open to amateurs only.

Classes 218, 219, 220

Lyn Walton Memorial Medal: Same specifications as Short Stirrup Equitation and Rusty Stirrups Equitation. Top 4 riders may test at judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-9 only) Open to amateurs only.

Class 301

Warm Up – 2' (Open Card): No year-end awards. No points or ribbons to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height until next height change. May cross enter to ANY warmup class in Novice or Advanced rings.

Class 403, 411

Child/Adult Hunter 2': Open to all riders and all horses/ponies. To jump a course at the designated height. Manner and suitability to be emphasized. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT cross enter to any other O/F class exceeding the height designated on the same show day. Simple changes not penalized at judge's discretion. Open to amateurs only.

Classes 119, 120, 121

Child/Adult Equitation 2': Same specifications as Child/Adult Hunter with additional emphasis on rider's equitation. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other equitation O/F classes exceeding the height designated on same show day. Simple changes not penalized at judge's discretion.

Open to amateurs only.

Classes 221, 222, 223

Child/Adult Medal: Same specifications as Child/Adult Equitation. Top 4 riders may test at judge's discretion. Simple changes not penalized at judge's discretion. Open to amateurs only.
Class 302

Children's Pony Hunter: 2' Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. Manners and suitability to be emphasized. To jump a course at the designated height. Simple changes not penalized at judge's discretion. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT cross enter to any other O/F classes exceeding the height designated on same show day.
Classes 122, 123, 124

Children's Pony Equitation: Same specifications as Children's Pony Hunter with additional emphasis on rider's equitation. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other equitation O/F classes exceeding the height designated on same show day.
Classes 224, 225, 226

Children's Pony Medal: Same specifications as Children's Pony Equitation. Top 4 riders may test at judge's discretion. Simple changes not penalized at judge's discretion.
Class 303

Mulligan Hunter Class: This is an open card that will run all day. If you don't have a good first round and want to redo the same round unjudged, you may ask the ingate to ask the judge for permission to enter this class. The mulligan class cannot precede a regular class round. The class will be held separately, and will not replace the original score. It is at the discretion of the judge to allow, or disallow the round for any reason. It is at the discretion of the ingate to schedule this round as they can accommodate into their order. It is at the discretion of the show manager to limit, add or cancel this class at anytime. No year end awards. No points or ribbons will be awarded.

Mother's Day Leadline: Open to current member mothers. To be shown at the walk.
Class 700

Father's Day Leadline: Open to current member fathers. To be shown at the walk.
Class 800

Junior Barn Challenge: \$35 entry fee. 2 or 3 riders per team. Top 2 scores will be added together. (3 riders, lowest score will be dropped – 2 riders, no dropped scores)
Barns may combine if needed. Junior/amateur riders only. Open to Short/Rusty Stirrups and 2' riders. Please let your ingate know which height you will be jumping. Class will run at the end of the day.

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ADVANCED RING**

Warm Up – 2'3" (Open Card): No year-end awards. No points or ribbons to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height until next height change. May cross enter to ANY warmup class in Novice or Advanced rings.

Class 405, 413

Modified Child/Adult Hunter 2'3": Open to junior and adult amateur riders only. To jump a course at 2'3". Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT cross enter to O/F classes exceeding 2'3" on same show day. Manners and suitability to be emphasized.

Classes 125, 126, 127

Modified Child/Adult 2'3" Handy Hunter: Open to junior and adult amateur riders only. To jump a course at 2'3". Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT cross enter to O/F classes exceeding 2'3" on same show day. The Handy Hunter round shall be judged on jumping style and efficiency while maintaining style and form, way of going, and overall flow. Pace, brilliance, and handiness are to be rewarded.

Class 150

Modified Child/Adult Equitation 2'3": Open to junior and adult amateur riders only. Same specifications as Child/Adult Hunter 2'3" with additional emphasis on rider's equitation. Same rider MAY NOT cross enter to any other equitation O/F classes exceeding the height designated on same show day.

Classes 227, 228, 229

Modified Child/Adult Medal: Open to junior and adult amateur riders only. To jump an equitation course at 2'3" Top 4 riders may be tested. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT cross enter to O/F classes exceeding 2'3" on same show day. Open to 2'3" Pony division.

Class 304

Pony Hunter – 2'3": Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT enter to O/F classes exceeding the height on same show day. To be judged on manners and suitability.

Classes 128, 129, 131

Pony 2'3" Handy Hunter: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT enter to O/F classes exceeding the height on same show day. The Handy Hunter round shall be judged on jumping style and efficiency while maintaining style and form, way of going, and overall flow. Pace, brilliance, and handiness are to be rewarded.

Class 130

Pony Equitation – 2'3": Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. Same specifications as Pony Hunter 2'3" with additional emphasis on rider's equitation.

Classes 230, 231, 232

Warm Up – 2'6" (Open Card): No year-end awards. No points or ribbons to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height (2'3" on the verticals and 2'6" on the oxers) until next height change. May cross enter to ANY warmup class in Novice or Advanced rings.

Class 407, 415

Low Hunter 2'6": Open to all riders. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT enter to O/F classes exceeding the height designated on same show day. To be judged on manners and suitability.

Classes 132, 133, 134, 239

Low Handy Hunter 2'6": Open to all riders. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT enter to O/F classes exceeding the height designated on same show day. The Handy Hunter round shall be judged on jumping style and efficiency while maintaining style and form, way of going, and overall flow. Pace, brilliance, and handiness are to be rewarded.

Class 240

Low Adult Am. Hunter 2'6": Open to riders 18 and older only as of December 1st. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT enter O/F classes exceeding the height designated on same show day. To be judged on manners and suitability.

Classes 135, 136, 137

Low Adult Handy Hunter 2'6": Open to riders 18 and older only as of December 1st. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT enter O/F classes exceeding the height designated on same show day. The Handy Hunter round shall be judged on jumping style and efficiency while maintaining style and form, way of going, and overall flow. Pace, brilliance, and handiness are to be rewarded.

Class 138

Low Adult Am. Equitation Hunter 2'6": Open to riders 18 and older only as of December 1st. Same specifications as Low Adult Am. Hunter with emphasis on rider's equitation.

Classes 233, 234, 235

Marshall & Sterling Low Adult 2'6" Medal: Open to Adult Amateur Riders that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences 3' or higher. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 2'6" including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count. May ONLY be combined with M&S 2'6" Children's Medal.

Class 306

Low Children's Hunter 2'6" – Margaux Grossman Memorial: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT cross enter to any O/F exceeding the height designated on same show day. Manners and suitability to be emphasized.

Classes 139, 140, 141

Low Children's Handy Hunter: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT cross enter to any O/F exceeding the height designated on same show day. The Handy Hunter round shall be judged on jumping style and efficiency while maintaining style and form, way of going, and overall flow. Pace, brilliance, and handiness are to be rewarded.

Class 142

Low Children's Equitation 2'6": Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT cross enter to any O/F exceeding the height designated on same show day. Manners and suitability to be emphasized with emphasis on rider's equitation.

Classes 236, 237, 238

Marshall & Sterling Dee Parker Memoriam Medal 2'6": Open to Junior Riders on horses or ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences the required height. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May ONLY be combined with M&S 2'6" Adult Medal.

Class 305

Warm Up – 3' (Open Card): No year-end awards. No points or ribbons to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height until next height change. May cross enter to ANY warmup class in Novice or Advanced rings.

Class 408, 416

Open Hunter 3': Open to all riders. Manners and suitability emphasized.

Class 143, 144, 145, 245

Open Handy Hunter 3': Open to all riders. The Handy Hunter round shall be judged on jumping style and efficiency while maintaining style and form, way of going, and overall flow. Pace, brilliance, and handiness are to be rewarded.

Class 244

Child Adult Amateur Hunter 3': Open to junior and adult amateur riders only. To jump a course at 3'. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT cross enter to O/F classes exceeding 3' on same show day. Manners and suitability to be emphasized.

Class 146, 147, 148

Child/Adult Amateur Handy Hunter 3': Open to junior and adult amateur riders only. To jump a course at 3'. Same horse/rider combination MAY NOT cross enter to O/F classes exceeding 3' on same show day. The Handy Hunter round shall be judged on jumping style and efficiency while maintaining style and form, way of going, and overall flow. Pace, brilliance, and handiness are to be rewarded.

Class 149

Child Adult Amateur Equitation 3': Same specifications as Child Adult Amateur Hunter with additional emphasis on rider's equitation.

Class 241, 242, 243

Child/Adult Medal 3': Open to Adult Amateur Riders. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count. May be combined with Child Horse and/or Pony Medal

Class 307

Specialty Classes – Advance Ring

Child/Adult Hunter Derby: \$200 entry fee. Two designated heights of 2'3" and 2'6". There will be two rounds. First round, classic and second round, handy. Top 8 riders will advance to second round. Open to child/adult riders. Amateurs only.

Riders may not cross enter from their respective divisions on the weekend to a lower or higher height of the derby. However, riders currently competing in the 2' divisions may compete in the derby at the 2'3" height. No points or year end will be awarded.

Class 700

Barn Challenge: \$35 entry fee. 2 or 3 riders per team. Top 2 scores will be added together. (3 riders, lowest score will be dropped – 2 riders, no dropped scores)

Barns may combine if needed. Junior/amateur riders only. 3' riders can enter class 601 at 2'6". Please let your ingate know which height you will be jumping. Class will run at the end of the day.

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JUMPER RING**

Schooling Jumper Cross Rails (Table II): No year-end awards or points to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height until next height change. May cross enter to ANY Warmup or Schooling class in Novice or Advanced rings. Clear Blue Ribbon Round
Class 420, 421

Cross Rail Jumper: Open to all horses and ponies. Jumps not to exceed 18". Courses will NOT include oxers or combinations. Riders may not cross enter in any classes exceeding 18" in height. Professional riders are not allowed to compete in this section.
Class 501, 502, 515, 516

Schooling Jumper .60 (Table II): No year-end awards or points to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height until next height change. May cross enter to ANY Warmup or Schooling Class. Clear Blue Ribbon Round
Class 430, 431

.60 Beginner Jumper: Open to all horses and ponies. Jumps not to exceed .60M Courses will not include oxers or combinations. Riders may cross enter in one consecutive division/height. Professional riders are not allowed to compete in this section.
Class 503, 504, 517, 518

Schooling Jumper .70-.80 (Table II): No year-end awards or points to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height until next height change. May cross enter to ANY Warmup or Schooling Class. Clear Blue-Ribbon Round
Class 440, 441

.70-.80 Puddle Jumper: Open to all horses. Jumps not to exceed .80M or 2'6". Riders may cross enter in one consecutive division/height. Courses will not include combinations.
Class 505, 506, 519, 520

Schooling Jumper .90 (Table II): No year-end awards or points to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height until next height change. May cross enter to ANY Warmup or Schooling Class. Clear Blue-Ribbon Round
Class 450, 451

.90 Training Jumper: Open to all horses to jump .90M. Riders may cross enter in one consecutive division/height. Courses may include combinations.
Class 507, 508, 521, 522

Schooling Jumper 1.0m (Table II): No year-end awards or points to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height until next height change. May cross enter to ANY Warmup or Schooling Class. Clear Blue-Ribbon Round.
Class 460, 461

1.0M Training Jumper: Open to all horses to jump 1.0M or 3'3". Riders may cross enter in one consecutive division/height. Courses may include combinations.

Class 510, 511, 524, 525

1.0M Low Child/Adult Jumper: Open to all horses to jump 1.0M or 3'3". Riders may cross enter in one consecutive division/height. Courses may include combinations. Open to amateur riders only.

Class 530, 531, 532, 533

Schooling Jumper 1.10m (Table II): No year-end awards or points to be awarded. Class will be open at respective height until next height change. May cross enter to ANY Warmup or Schooling Class. Clear Blue Ribbon Round

Class 470, 471

1.10M Training Jumper: Open to all horses to jump 1.10M or 3'7", Riders may cross enter in one consecutive division/height. Courses may include combinations.

Class 513, 514, 527, 528

1.10M Low Child/Adult Jumper: Open to all horses to jump 1.10M or 3'7". Riders may cross enter in one consecutive division/height. Courses may include combinations. Open to amateur riders only.

Class 534, 535, 536, 537

Mulligan Class: This is an open card that will run all day. If you don't have a good first round and want to redo the same round unjudged, you may ask the in gate to ask the judge for permission to enter this class. The mulligan class cannot precede a regular class round. The class will be held separately and will not replace the original score. It is at the discretion of the judge to allow or disallow the round for any reason. It is at the discretion of the in gate to schedule this round as they can accommodate into their order. It is at the discretion of the show manager to limit, add or cancel this class at anytime. No year end awards. No points or ribbons will be awarded.

Specialty Classes – Jumper Ring

Jumper Classics: Conducted as a Table II 2.2(b) immediate jump off. In the event of equality of faults after the first round, there will be one jump off for the first place only in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults in the jump off. Course will consist of a minimum of 8-10 jumps at their respective heights. No points or year end will be awarded.

Class 800, 810, 820, 830, 840, 850
